

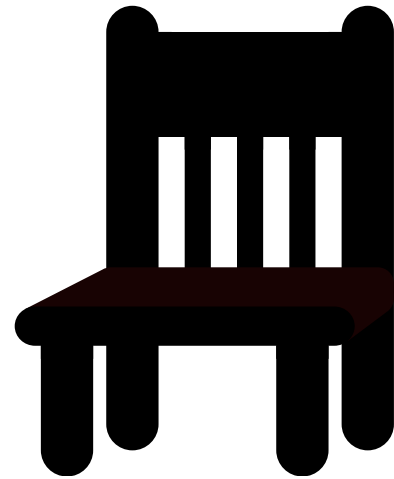

The Chair

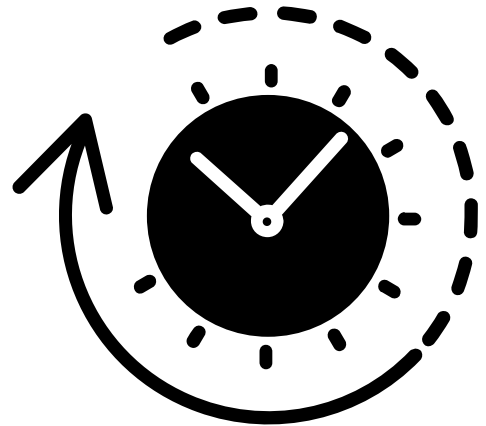

The Pen

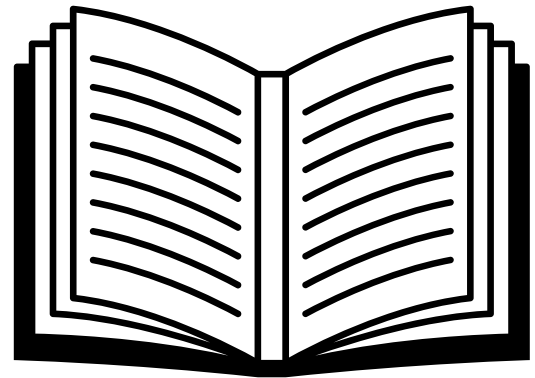

The Refrigerator

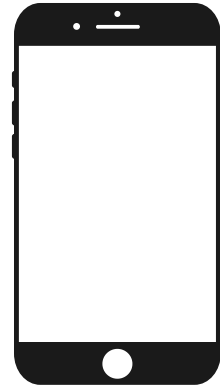
