I am a banana, long and yellow.


Monkeys love eating me.

I am an orange, round and juicy.


I am rich in vitamin C.

Grapes




I am a bunch of grapes, small and sweet.

I have a crown of green leaves.


My inside is yellow and very sweet.

I am a watermelon, green outside and red inside.


I am full of water and refreshing in summer.

I am a mango, sweet and tropical.


I am known as the "king of fruits" in some countries.

My texture is soft and juicy.


I grow in orchards during autumn.
