Who lives down the lane.




Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

and the itsy bitsy spider went up the spout again.






Jack and Jill

Bake me a cake as fast as you can Pat it and prick it, and mark it with B, Put it in the oven for Baby and me.




One, Two, Buckle My Shoe
