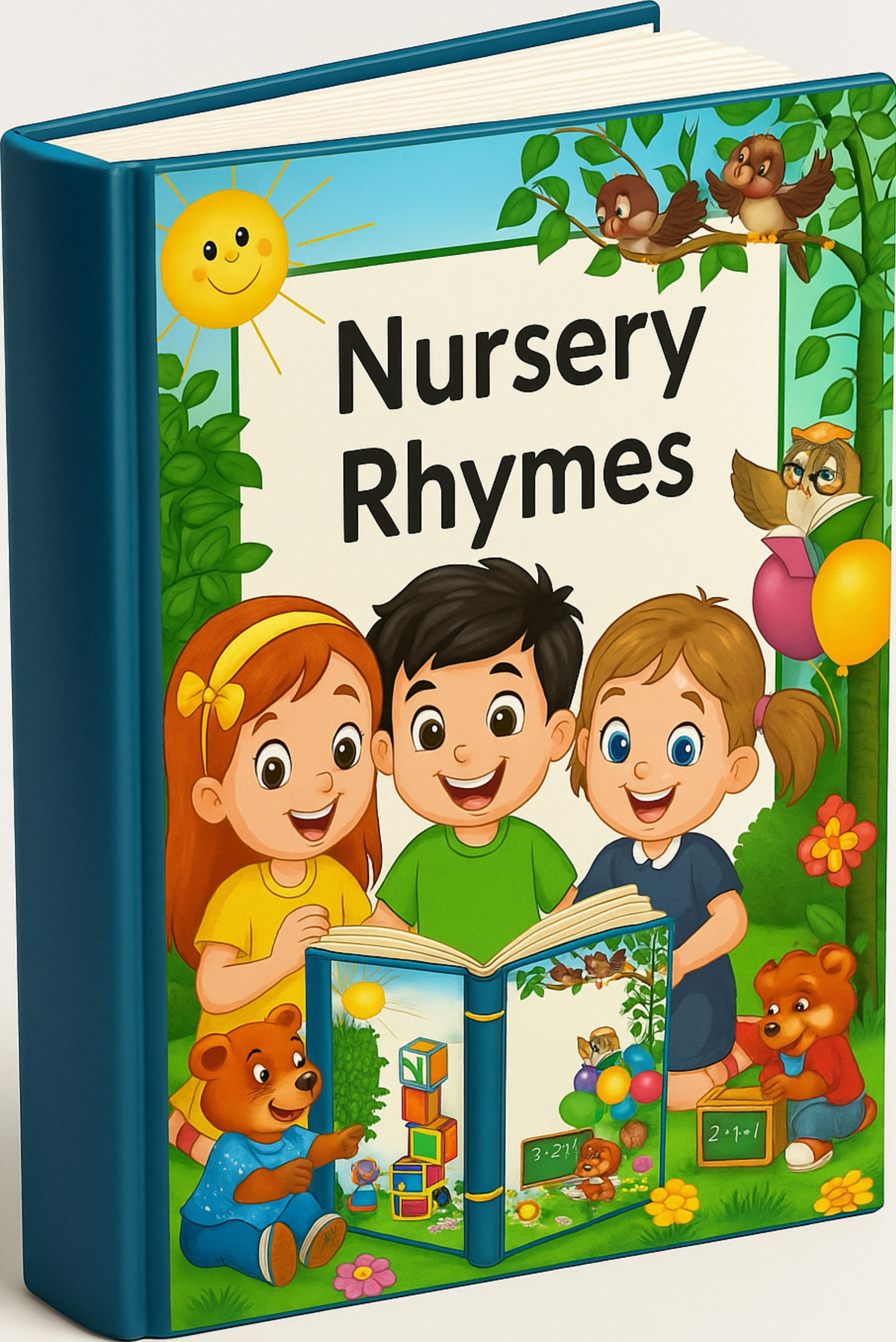

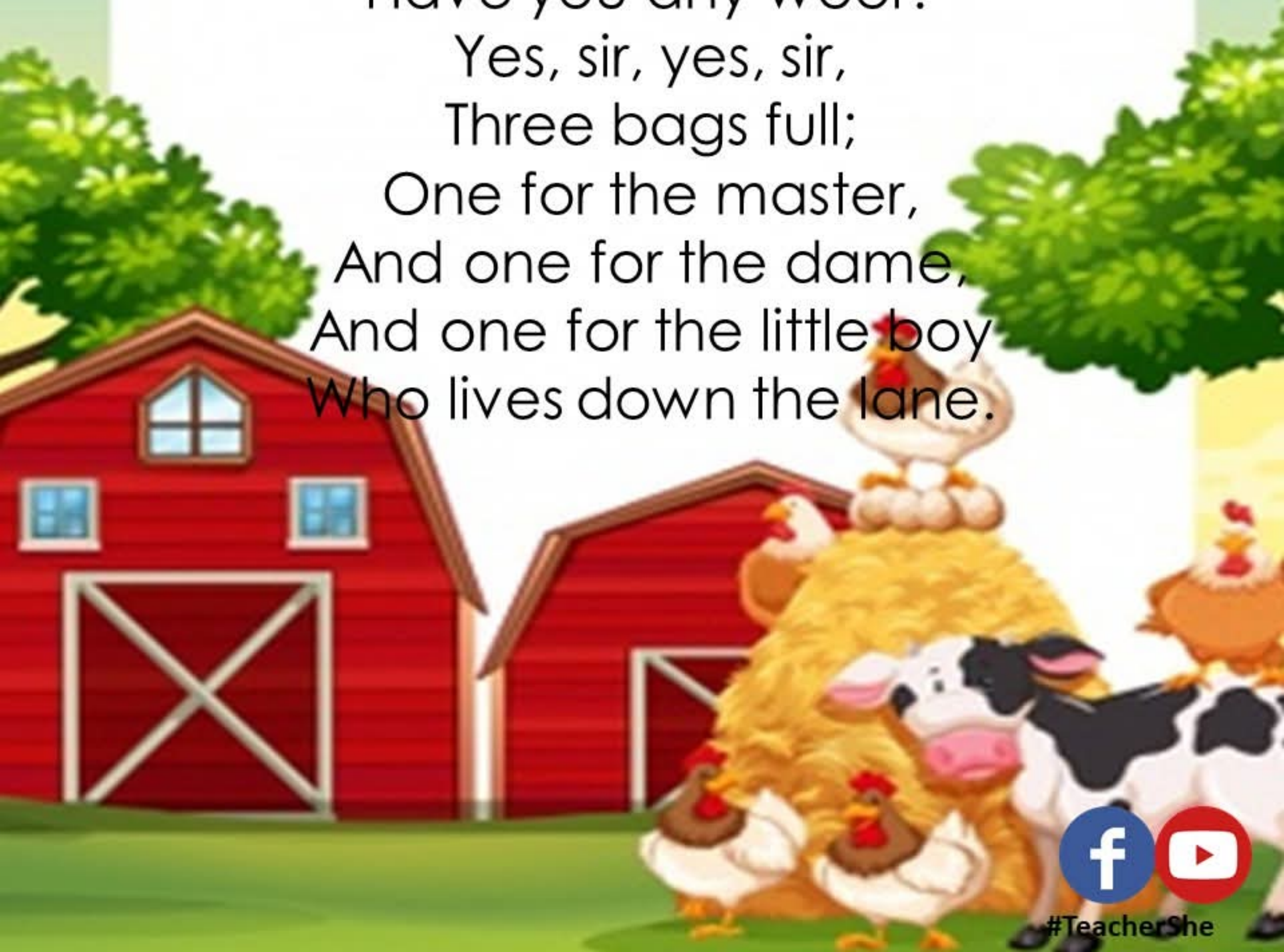

Like a diamond in the sky.



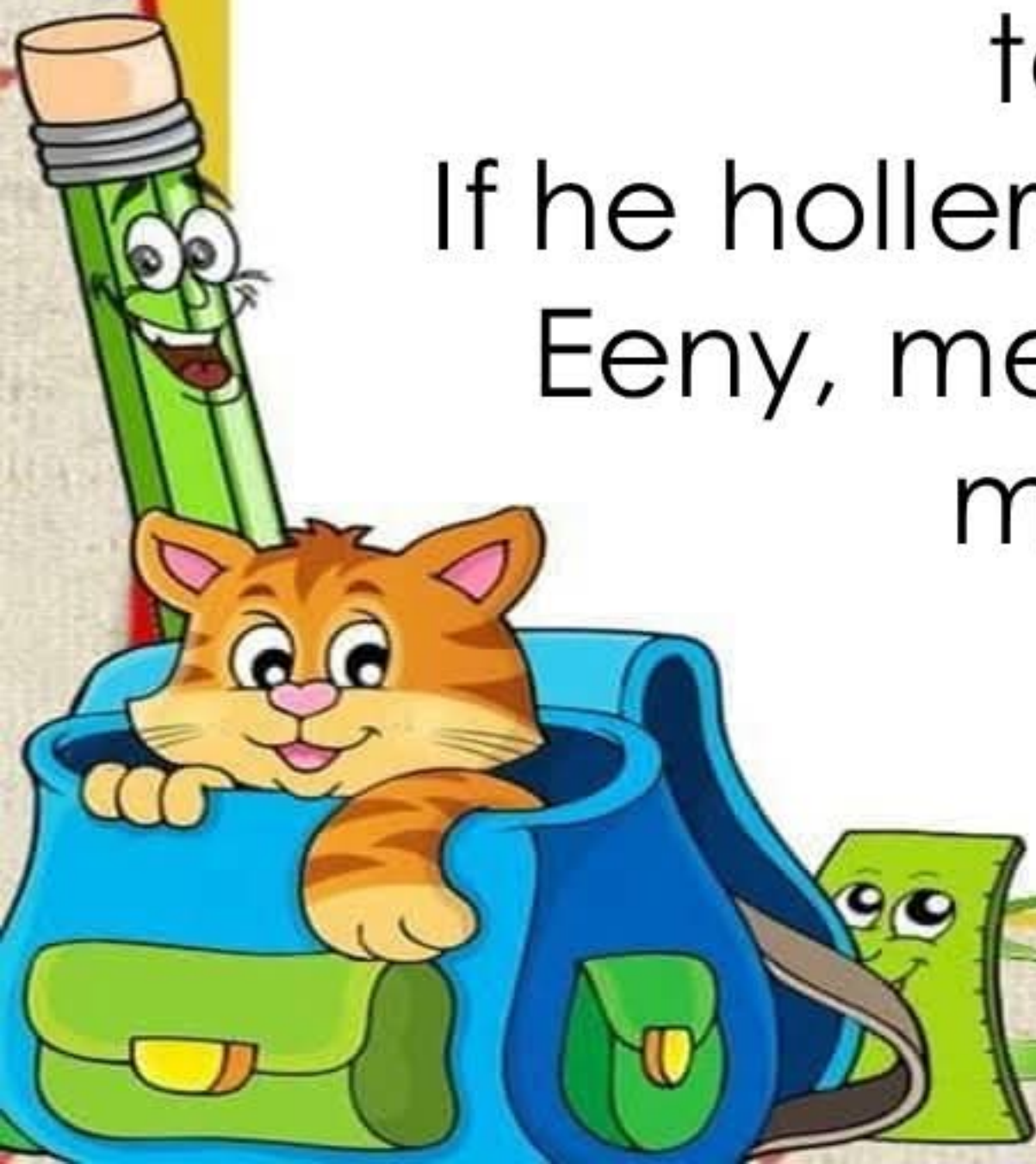

sleeps.

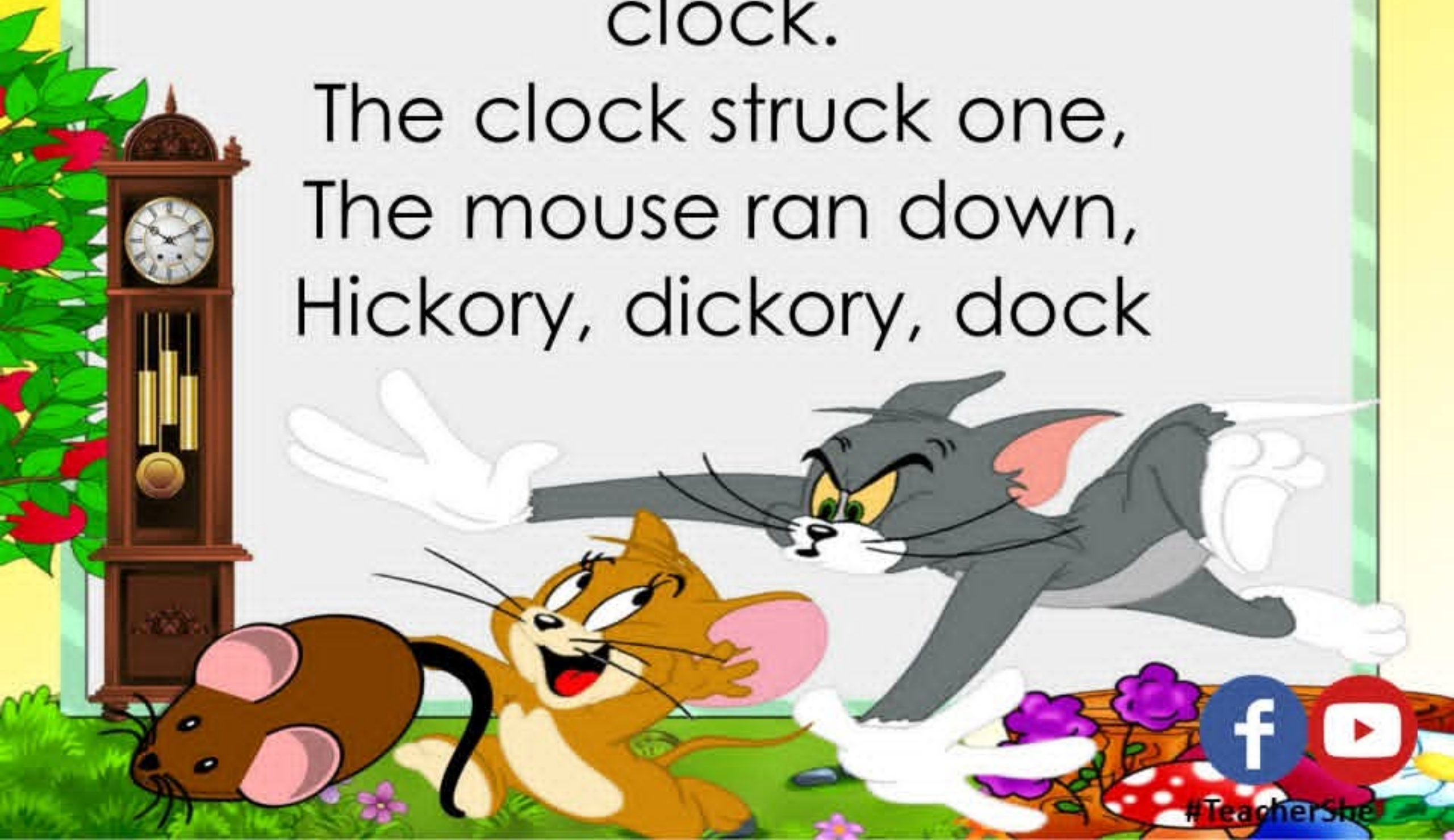

Nine, ten, a big fat hen.

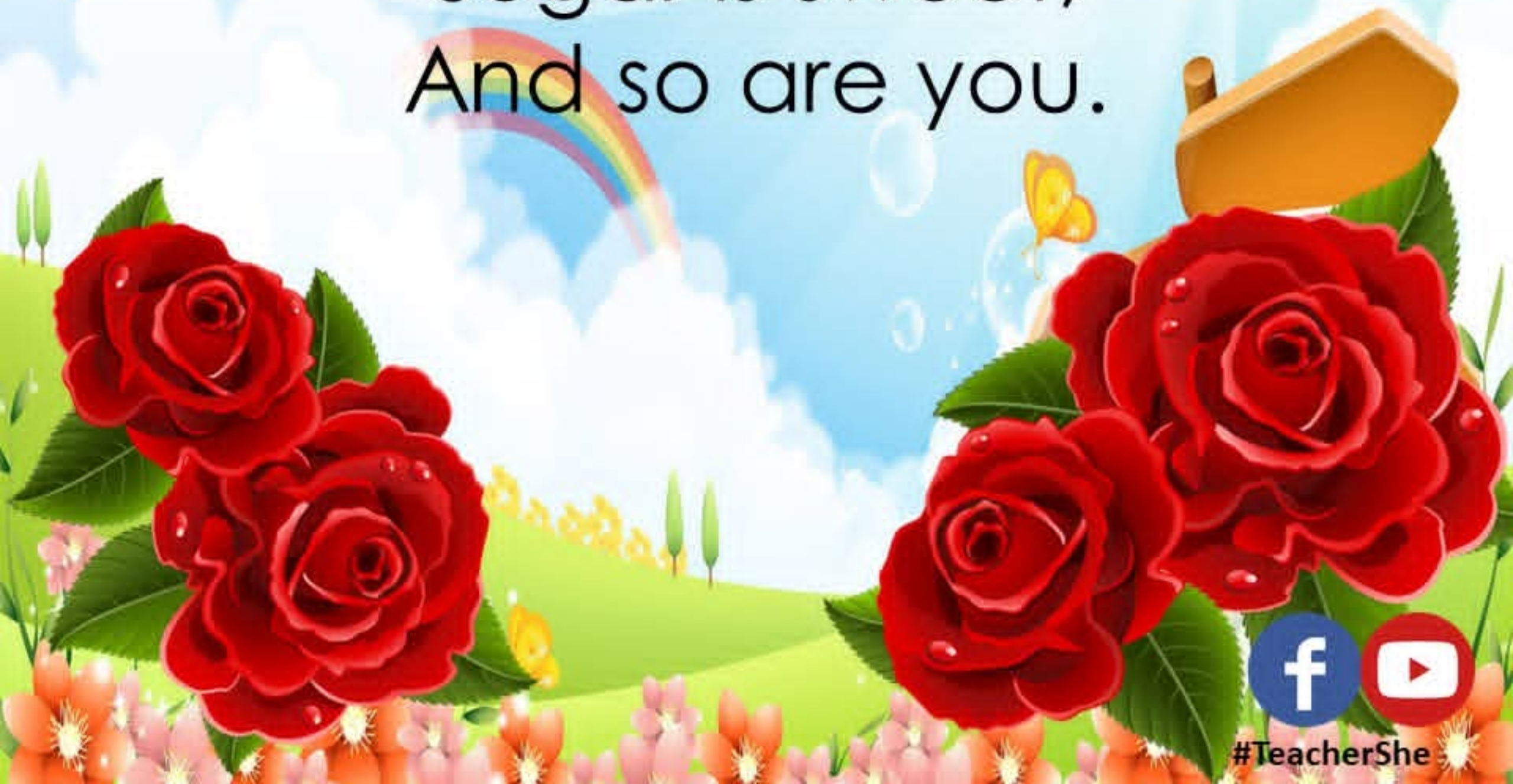
