## *Tips for Reading Together*

Children learn best when reading is fun.

- Talk about the **title** and the pictures on the cover.
- Look **through** the pictures together and discuss what you think the story might be about.
- Read the story together, pointing to the words and inviting **your** child to join in.
- Give lots of praise as **your** child reads with you, and help them when **necessary**.
- Have fun **finding** the hidden cats.
- Enjoy re-reading the story and encourage your **child** to say the repeated phrases with you.

Children enjoy reading stories again and again.  
This helps to build their confidence.
